

Oriental**Mutki**

Mutki is a Turkish Oriental that originated in eastern central Turkey. It is noticeably less sweet than Basma types. Usually sun-cured. Mostly used for cigarette and pipe blending. Even when sun-cured, it can serve as an interesting wrapper for small cigars. Mutki tip leaf (ootz) is intensely flavorful. Closer spacing and minimal fertilizer use will produce smaller, more fragrant and more traditional Turkish leaf. Wider spacing and increased fertilization will produce much larger leaf that lacks its Oriental character.
