**Mont-Calme Brun**

**Cigar**



Mont-Calme Brun (Brown) is a cigar wrapper variety from Switzerland. (Sota Experiment Station, Nyon) 1970. It is low in nicotine, and rather mild in taste and aroma. Resistant to black rot and PVYn. Classed by ARS-GRIN as “Cigar Wrapper.”

Apparent Pedigree:

- a) Mont-Calme de Martinet in 1906: Amersfoorter x White Burley.
- b) Mont-Calme **Jaune** de Rapin in 1927: Mont-Calme (de Martinet) x White Burley.
- c) Mont-Calme **Brun** de Rapin in 1927: Mont-Calme (de Martinet) x White Burley.

Mont-Calme **Brun** is considered worldwide to be a cigar variety.
